The Blood of Jesus

- The BLOOD gives us confidence – Hebrews 10:19
- The BLOOD gives us forgiveness – Matthew 26:28, Ephesians 1:7
- The BLOOD cleanses our conscience – Hebrews 9:14
- The BLOOD sanctifies us – Hebrews 13:12
- The BLOOD gives us the right to stand in victory over the devil – Revelation 12:11
- The BLOOD rescues us from sin – 1 Peter 1:18-19
- The BLOOD allows us to come near to God – Ephesians 2:13
- The BLOOD gives us peace with God – Colossians 1:20
- The BLOOD allows us to have fellowship with one another – 1 John 1:7
- The BLOOD gives us an everlasting covenant with God – Hebrews 13:20

Authority

- 2 Chronicles 20:17 (AMP) You will not have to fight this battle. Take up your positions; stand firm and see the deliverance the Lord will give you, Judah and Jerusalem. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow, and the Lord will be with you.
- Luke 10:19 (AMP) Listen carefully: I have given you authority [that you now possess] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and [the ability to exercise authority] over all the power of the enemy (Satan); and nothing will [in any way] harm you.
- 2 Corinthians 10:3-6 (AMP) For though we walk in the flesh [as mortal men], we are not carrying on our [spiritual] warfare according to the flesh and using the weapons of man. 4 The weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood]. Our weapons are divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. 5 We are destroying sophisticated arguments and every exalted and proud thing that sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought and purpose captive to the obedience of Christ, 6 being ready to punish every act of disobedience, when your own obedience [as a church] is complete.
- Colossians 2:15 (AMP) When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities [those supernatural forces of evil operating against us], He made a public example of them

[exhibiting them as captives in His triumphal procession], having triumphed over them through the cross.

- 1 John 4:4 (AMP) Little children (believers, dear ones), you are of God and you belong to Him and have [already] overcome them [the agents of the antichrist]; because He who is in you is greater than he (Satan) who is in the world [of sinful mankind].
